

Haul Out Information

All scheduling will be done through Lynn at the marina office (651-388-5839). Another option would be to send your contract in the mail with your preferred time and date of haul out. This should be signed and dated, with your payment included. Once we receive this information, Lynn will call you back to confirm. Also, please update any information on the contract that is incorrect. All winter contracts must be received by October 1st, to help plan our haul out schedule.

When scheduling your pullout please have a time and day when you would like to be pulled out. We will try our best to follow through with your request. If at all possible it would work best for us if you could be pulled anywhere from eight until ten in the morning. We understand that this time might not be convenient for everyone, so other times will be available. Mon, Tues, Thurs, Fri from 8 am - 3 pm and Saturdays from 8 am - 10am. Also when scheduling your pullout please let us know when you are planning to launch in the spring. This way we can better place you in the storage yard.

There are a few things you must do before pulling out.

1. Bring your boat to our upper harbor at Bay Point Park.
2. Get a pump out.
3. Leave your keys in your boat or arrive on the day of pulling a **HALF AN HOUR EARLY!!**

We will begin pulling boats in September until the last day on October. Any boats that need to be pulled after this date will be subject to additional fees. Also, additional fees will be added to boats that aren't in running order. Please note: If you are **not on time** for your scheduled pulling, we will fit you in at the next available time.

Water and electricity will be available throughout the yard, but if the weather turns bad the water will be drained early.

Again this year, there will be high pressure cleaning for the bottom of your boat. The cost will be \$65 for boats up to 35ft and \$85 for boats over 35ft. Also, keep in mind that shrink wrapping can only be done by a licensed contractor. After you are finished with your boat, please clean up around your area.
