



Ole Miss Maritime Message

Just a few final notes for the 2010 boating season. This will be the last newsletter for the year. Next year, newsletters will be published on our website and copies at the gas dock.

All boats and trailers NOT being stored for winter must be removed from our lot by September 15th. Only exception is if your trailer is for a boat you have slipped with Ole Miss.

Haul out note: Your boat will not be hauled out unless we have a signed storage contract. If you are not storing with us you are responsible for scheduling your own haul-out.

HOFFMAN CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN WORK

Shortly after the Labor Day weekend, Hoffman Construction will begin work at the bulkheads in the Upper Harbor. Hoffman is working with the Army Corps of Engineers on significant improvements to Lock and Dam #3. The project will involve the offloading dredge materials and the loading of rock and fill materials. The activity will take place Monday thru Friday throughout the fall of 2010 and most of the 2011 boating season.

We have worked extensively with Hoffman in an effort to minimize the inconvenience to boaters. But please know there will be a significant increase in traffic and noise during the weekdays.
